We have noticed a recent increase in burglaries and thefts where items including beer and soft drinks are being stolen from refrigerators inside garages. The weather is getting nicer and people are doing spring planting and yard work. Leaving the garage door open may be convenient for you, but it is also convenient for would be thirsty thieves as an open invitation to relieve you of your beverages and anything else of value kept in the garage. Please keep garage doors closed when you are not out in them.

Some other theft prevention tips:

- Have an exterior alarm siren, so that your neighbors will hear your alarm if it goes off*
- If you hear a neighbors alarm, car or house sounding, call 911 immediately*
- Make sure your alarm company has current contact information*
- If you have strangers (workers, repairmen) in your house hide all your jewelry and other valuables*
- Do not post your schedule on Face Book, Twitter, ect...*
- If you have a safe, good idea, secure to floor or wall and make sure it is hidden or completely out of sight*
- Keep a list of serial numbers and take pictures of your jewelry and other valuables and keep that list locked up*
- Regularly go through your residence and make sure all of your doors and windows are locked*

Be very observant of any suspicious or criminal activity in and or around your subdivision. If you see any suspicious activity, please call 911 immediately.
