## WHAT DO WE DO?

We contact new homeowners and arrange a visit to deliver the Princeton Square **Welcome Packet**. We may also choose to deliver baked goods or other treat depending on our available time and the nature of the visit.

## WHY DO WE DO IT?

We like meeting new people and our HOA wants every new homeowner to feel welcomed. It's a perfect fit! We like being a contact point to help answer questions or find someone who can. Mostly we do it to maintain that neighborly community feeling.

## WHAT IS INVOLVED?

We receive the contact information of new owners (average = 1/month). We call each one to arrange a visit, if possible, or at least drop off our **Welcome Packet**. Our level of involvement depends on our available time and number of Committee members.

## HOW CAN YOU HELP?

There are lot of ways to help -- phone, visit, print flyers, search the Internet for information. Update **Welcome Packets** with new flyers, brochures, menus, coupons from local businesses – whatever you feel is useful. Try new ideas (e.g., a Welcome Basket [Board approved, of course] of small, useful items. Pre-approved expenses are reimbursable. Time commitment: 1 hours/month. Helpful skills: email and MS Word.
